EXPERIENCE THE 15,000 M² FAN ZONE – A PARADISE FOR HANDBALL FANS!

The handball party starts long before the matches! During the Men's EHF EURO, we open the doors to the Fan Zone – and this time it's bigger and better than ever. Expect more fun, more excitement, and even more amazing fan activities to get your pulse racing.

Dive into mini handball and foosball or challenge the national team players virtually. Get your face painted, shop the latest merchandise, and explore the large handball museum. When hunger or thirst strikes, plenty of food and drink stalls are ready to serve you.

NOTE: Access to the Fan Zone requires a valid handball ticket

The Fan Zone is open on all match days. "Handball – Danish Cultural Heritage" (the hall where the museum is located) will be closed on January 15, 17, and 19. It will be open on all other match days.

ARRIVE EARLY

Arrive about 60 minutes before match start. Allow time for parking, walking from the parking lot to Jyske Bank Boxen, and the mandatory security check. Even if queues occur, security checks will not be compromised.

TICKET CONTROL

Access to Jyske Bank Boxen is via entrances 4 and 5. All tickets will be scanned.

BODY SEARCH

For everyone's safety, all guests will be fully searched at the entrance.

CLOTHING

It can get warm inside the arena – dress accordingly in layers.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

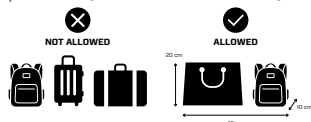
The following items are NOT allowed:

- Laptops, tablets, iPads
- Cameras (all sizes) and professional equipment
- Video and audio recorders
- Backpacks and large bags
- Umbrellas, gifts, weapons (including pepper spray)
- Air horns, megaphones, drums
- Bicycle batteries
- Selfie sticks, GoPros, laser pointers, fireworks
- Folding chairs and stools
- Food and drinks (including snacks and bottles) – exceptions for allergies

Note: No storage is available for these items. They will be rejected at the entrance. Mobile phones with camera function are allowed.

BAG RULES

Large bags and suitcases are not allowed. Only handbags are permitted (max size: 20 x 15 x 10 cm).



FLAGS, BANNERS & CLOTHING

It is permitted to bring flags and banners and to wear clothing without political messages, etc. in Jyske Bank Boxen.

See restrictions:

FLAGS AND BANNERS ARE ALLOWED IF THEY:

- Are official national flags of participating countries
 - Max size: 1 x 1.5 m
 - Do not block other guests' view
- Plastic flagpoles allowed (max length: 60 cm). No metal poles.

MERCHANDISE

Available in the Fan Zone and inside Jyske Bank Boxen.

FOOD, DRINKS & PAYMENT

Cold and hot drinks, snacks, and fast food is available inside Jyske Bank Boxen and the arrival building. In the Fan Zone, you will find food trucks and stalls offering burgers, hotdogs, sandwiches, snacks, pita, vegan/vegetarian options, and gluten-free alternatives. All major credit cards are accepted.

MEETING POINT

A "Meeting Point" banner is located in the arrival building (non-ticketed area).

SMOKING

Smoking is prohibited inside Jyske Bank Boxen and the Fan Zone. Outdoor smoking areas are available. Violations result in immediate expulsion.

CLOAKROOM

Available in the arrival building and foyer.

WHEELCHAIR ACCESS

Use the entrance indicated on your ticket. One helper per wheelchair. Handicap toilets are available in the arrival building, Fan Zone and in Jyske Bank Boxen.

TOILETS

Located inside Jyske Bank Boxen, in the Fan Zone, and in the arrival building.

CANCELLATION & REFUNDS

If the event is canceled, you will be refunded the ticket price (minus fees). Tickets cannot be resold for profit (see Danish law).

INFORMATION FOR STANDING TICKET HOLDERS

Standing areas offer an intense and energetic experience – a bit like a concert, where you stand close together and feel the atmosphere. To ensure everyone has a great and safe match day, here are some important things you need to know:

HOW THE STANDING SECTION WORKS

- You'll be standing close to other fans throughout the match – there are no seats.
- It is not permitted to bring walkers, stools, or any other equipment into the standing section.
- Always follow the instructions from our professional staff and volunteers, who are there for your safety and comfort.

PRACTICAL TIPS

- It gets warm when the atmosphere heats up! Avoid wearing clothes that are too warm and remember to drink plenty of water.
- Have questions? Our venue volunteers (blue shirts) and service team (black uniforms) are ready to help you.

We ensure the necessary safety with crowd barriers and volunteers to guide you. Together, we create the best atmosphere – we look forward to seeing you in the stands!

BY CAR

Free parking at MCH Messecenter Herning and Jyske Bank Boxen (P2, P3, P5). Handicap parking at P1 and P3.

DROP-OFF & PICK-UP

At *MCH Messecenter Hernings main building*, Vardevej 1.

TOUR BUSES

Use exit 41 and park at P4

BY BUS

Free shuttle buses between Herning Station and Jyske Bank Boxen on match days.
The buses depart from platform 7 at Herning Station and stop right outside Jyske Bank Boxen.

The first bus runs so you arrive at Jyske Bank Boxen when the Fan Zone opens. The last bus departs from Jyske Bank Boxen when there are no more waiting guests.

The buses operate as a shuttle service and do not run at fixed intervals. When a bus is full – either from Herning Station before the matches or from Jyske Bank Boxen after the matches – it departs, and you can wait for the next one.

TRAIN

Herning Messecenter Station is 700 m from Jyske Bank Boxen.
